Hampton Wick Library's book ordering service is available online at www.richmond.gov.uk/libraries or directly via the Library. You can pick up your books when it's convenient for you on Wednesdays, Fridays or Saturdays.

And if you need more than three weeks to finish your book you can also renew them online too.

And it's all FREE!

Other reasons why Hampton Wick Library's book ordering service* is better than Amazon:

- 1. No packaging to deal with. Don't you get fed up processing all that tough corrugated cardboard to fit in the recycling bin?
- 2. No missed deliveries.
